MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Designated Premises Supervisors

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence –

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Irresponsible Promotions

- (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to –
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Licensing act 2003);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on:
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

Dispensing Alcohol Directly in the Mouth

The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

Free Tap Water

The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

Age Verification

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and holographic mark.

Smaller Measures

The responsible person shall ensure that –

- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption of the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Exhibition of Films

No film shall be exhibited unless it has received a "U", "PG", "12A", "15" or "18" Certificate from the British Board of Film Classification ("BBFC"). Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the Certificate provided by the BBFC. Notwithstanding the above mentioned provision, a film may be exhibited and children may be admitted thereto if the permission of the Licensing Authority is first obtained and any recommendations of such permission are complied with. If the Licensing Authority does not agree with the category I which any film passed by the BBFC is placed, it shall be at liberty to alter such category and on notice of such alteration being given by the Licensing Authority to the holder of this certificate, the film thereafter shall be treated as having been placed in the altered category and the condition applicable to the exhibition of films in such altered category shall be complied with.

Door Supervision

Any person who carries out a security activity at the premises must either be:

- (a) authorised to carry out that security activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Act 2001; or
- (b) entitled to carry out that security activity by virtue of section 4 of the Private Security Act 2001

ANNEXE 3 – OPERATING SCHEDULE AND AGREED CONDITIONS

Crime and Disorder

1. The premises shall be equipped with a CCTV system that shall comply with the following criteria:
 - (a) The system shall be maintained in property working order.
 - (b) The system shall display on any recording, the correct time and date of the recording.
 - (c) The system shall be recording during all operating times.
 - (d) The recorded VCR tapes or digital recording media shall be held for a minimum of 31 days after the recording is made and shall be made available to the police for inspection on request as soon as reasonable practicable.
 - (e) Entrance, immediate stairs and main bar.
 - (f) CCTV signage shall be displayed as specified in the police crime prevention report.
2. Only glasses which are made of toughened glass (when available) shall be used on the premises.
3. Only persons who are 18 years of age and over shall be able to sell or supply alcohol with the exception of the supply of alcohol with a table meal.
4. The premises shall have in place a written check 21 policy. This policy shall be actively promoted and state that any person to which the sale or supply is being made who looks or appears to be under 21 years of age, shall be asked to provide identification that they are 18 years of age or over. The following forms of identification are acceptable:
 - (a) Passport;
 - (b) Photo driving licence;
 - (c) PASS accredited holographic proof of age card; or
 - (d) Any other form of identification agreed with Preston Police Licensing Unit.

Signs promoting this policy shall be prominently displayed at public entrances and alcohol sales areas.

5. Customers shall be allowed 30 minutes drinking up time after the last sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises.
6. On Fridays and Saturdays a management risk assessment will be made with regard to the need for door supervisors and the appropriate number (if any) will be used from 22.00 hours until half an hour after the premises close to the public

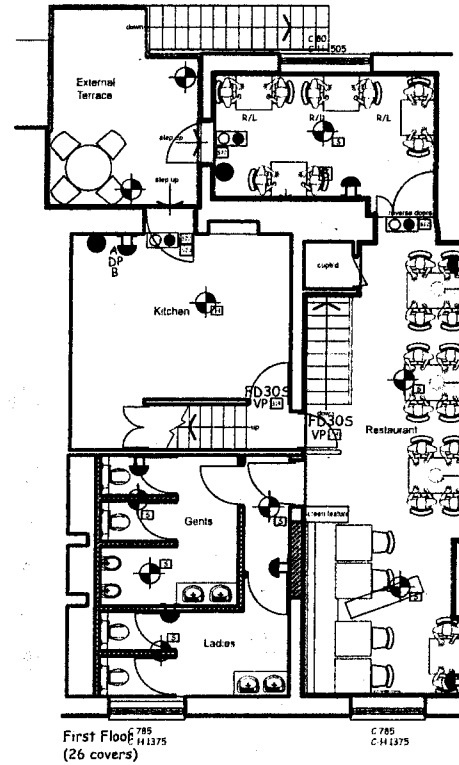
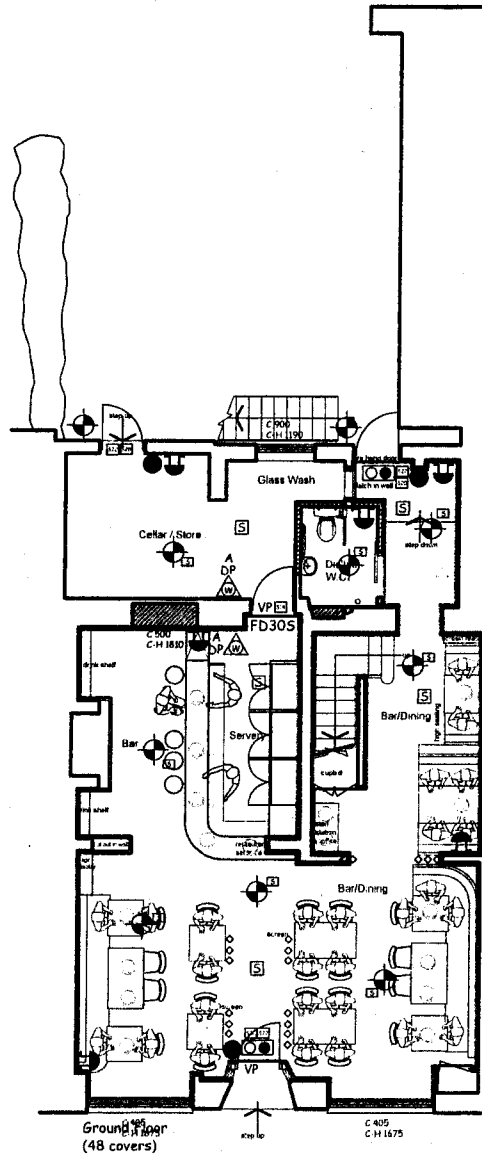

GENERAL NOTES

- 1 Provide New Emergency Lighting installation to serve all public areas, toilets, lobbies, exit routes and private exit routes, private accommodation, cellar, kitchen, all back of house area, including illuminated EXIT signs. Electrician to install new scheme in accordance with BS 5266: Part 1: 1988 to Building Control and Fire Officers approval. Note: All circulation area to be Non-Maintained. All toilets, corridors, staff areas, stores, directional exit signs & signs over exit doors to be Fully Maintained.
 - 2 Provide New Fire Alarm System throughout, including break glass fire alarm call points, alarm bell sounders (to be audible in all parts of building), and heat and smoke detectors to be installed in accordance with BS 5839: Part 1: 1982 to meet Building Control and Fire Officers approval. All sockets and power supplies to Music Systems to be linked to Fire Alarm and all power to be cut upon activation of Fire Alarm.
 - 3 Provide AFFF type fire extinguisher and fire blanket / dry powder type fire extinguisher to commercial kitchen.
 - 4 All upholstery fabrics / foam and curtain fabrics to be fire retardant and contractor to provide test certificates to fire officer for approval prior to completion of works. Minimum Crab '5'.
 - 5 Wall and ceiling linings to be Class 1 generally and Class 0 to escape lobbies and stairwells.
 - 6 Means of escape to comply with Building Control / Fire Officers requirements.
 - 7 All doors marked FD30S to be 1/2 hour fire resistant construction and fitted with combined smoke seals and intumescent strips and self closing device. Any glazing to be to 1/2 hour resistant standard.
 - 8 All doors marked FD60S to be 1 hour fire resistant construction and fitted with combined smoke seals and intumescent strips and self closing device. Any glazing to be to 1 hour resistant standard.
 - 9 Provide fire signs and notices as required by Building Control / Fire Officer.
 - 10 Check / upgrade stair soffits to 1 hour fire resisting standard.
 - 11 Check / upgrade existing ceilings between a) basement cellar and ground floor trading areas, and b) ground floor trading areas and first floor.
 - 12 Upgrade electrical power / lighting circuits to current IEE regulations with NICEIC certificates.
 - 13 Wire and install New Noise Limiter - Formula Sound Century together with a Contactor linked to the Music System power supplies which will be calibrated and set at a level that if amplified music / live music exceeds the set decibel level the power supply will be automatically switched off and will only switch on if the amplification unit noise output is reduced to under the set decibel level. An appointment will be made with Greenwich Borough Council Environment Health Officer at such a time when this unit is ready to be Calibrated and the Decibel level set to ensure the level is satisfactory.
- b). No External Speakers shall be installed at any time.
- c). All Amplified Music / Amplified Live Entertainment shall only take place internally.
- d). All external doors and windows in the premises will remain closed at any time when Amplified Music / Amplified Live Entertainment is played, except for the duration of access and egress or in the event of an emergency.
- e). Signs will be installed externally in the following areas. Adjacent front entrance door adjacent rear entrance door, within designated covered smoking area, adjacent entrance to car park from entrance to road. Please leave the premises quietly and respect our neighbours.
