RE: 3 STREAM WHEELED BIN REFUSE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING SERVICE

Following a highly successful trial of the Council's new wheeled bin refuse collection and recycling service I am pleased to be able to tell you that the new service is coming to your area and will start week commencing **Monday 29th October 2007**.

Over the next 3 or 4 weeks either 2 or 3 wheeled bins will be delivered to your property. Those properties that have been considered likely to generate green/garden waste for disposal will get 3 x 140ltr wheeled bins in total. A burgundy bin for the waste that cannot be recycled, a blue bin for glass, cans and plastic bottles that can be recycled and the green bin for garden waste which will be composted. Other properties will receive 2 bins, a burgundy one and a blue one. However if you believe you should have got a green bin and did not then please ring our help line for advice.

The waste in the burgundy bin will be collected every week and the blue and green bins collected on alternate weeks. More detailed information about what can be put in each bin, a calendar giving your days of collection and some answers to frequently asked questions will be included in a leaflet that will be left for you with your bins when they are delivered to your property shortly. Please read the information provided as this will help you to make the best use of the bins you've been given, help us to provide you with an efficient and effective service and ensure as much waste as possible is recycled.

In your case your wheeled bins are to be left at a designated collection point near to your property. Your nearest collection point is indicated by the black circle on the enclosed plan. Please make sure when leaving your bins there they do not cause an obstruction to users of the road, track or footpath. PLEASE DO NOT PUT OUT THE BINS FOR COLLECTION BEFORE MONDAY 29th OCTOBER 2007.
