

**PROPOSAL FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD
PLAN
(Localism Act 2011; Part 6-116 Neighbourhood Planning)**

Background

Longridge Town Council at its meeting on 8th May 2013 authorised a working group to advance a Longridge Neighbourhood Plan.

Proposed Area

The proposed neighbourhood plan will cover the area currently bounded by the Longridge Town Council consisting of the Alston, Derby and Dilworth wards.

Support

The Alston, Derby and Dilworth wards comprise the principal core of the community of Longridge.

The Neighbourhood Plan will further develop the more general and wide-reaching town plan for Longridge covering business and residents aspirations that has been developed by the community partnership over the last five years.

The Town Council will provide a structure for the development of the plan and establish a forum for consultation and community engagement.

Appropriate Body

Longridge Town Council is the body preparing the plan. It is believed that the Town Council is a relevant body for satisfying the purposes of Section 7 of Part 2 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (also section 61G of the 1990 Act).
