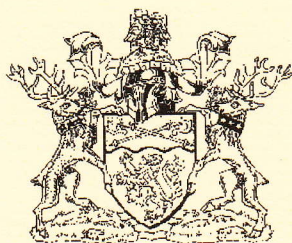
EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH No.44 RIBCHESTER

This Order is made by Ribble Valley Borough Council (the Authority) under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 (the 1980 Act) because it appears to the Authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order is not needed for public use.

The applicant has agreed to defray any expenses incurred by Ribble Valley Borough Council.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Ashmoor House, Ribchester shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after fourteen days from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified accordingly.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

Footpath No. 44.

From Ordnance Survey Grid Reference 6447 3604, Point A on the Order Plan in a generally northerly direction for approximately 148 metres, to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference 6448 3619 Point C on the Order Plan. The existing path is shown by a bold line on the Order Plan and marked A – C.

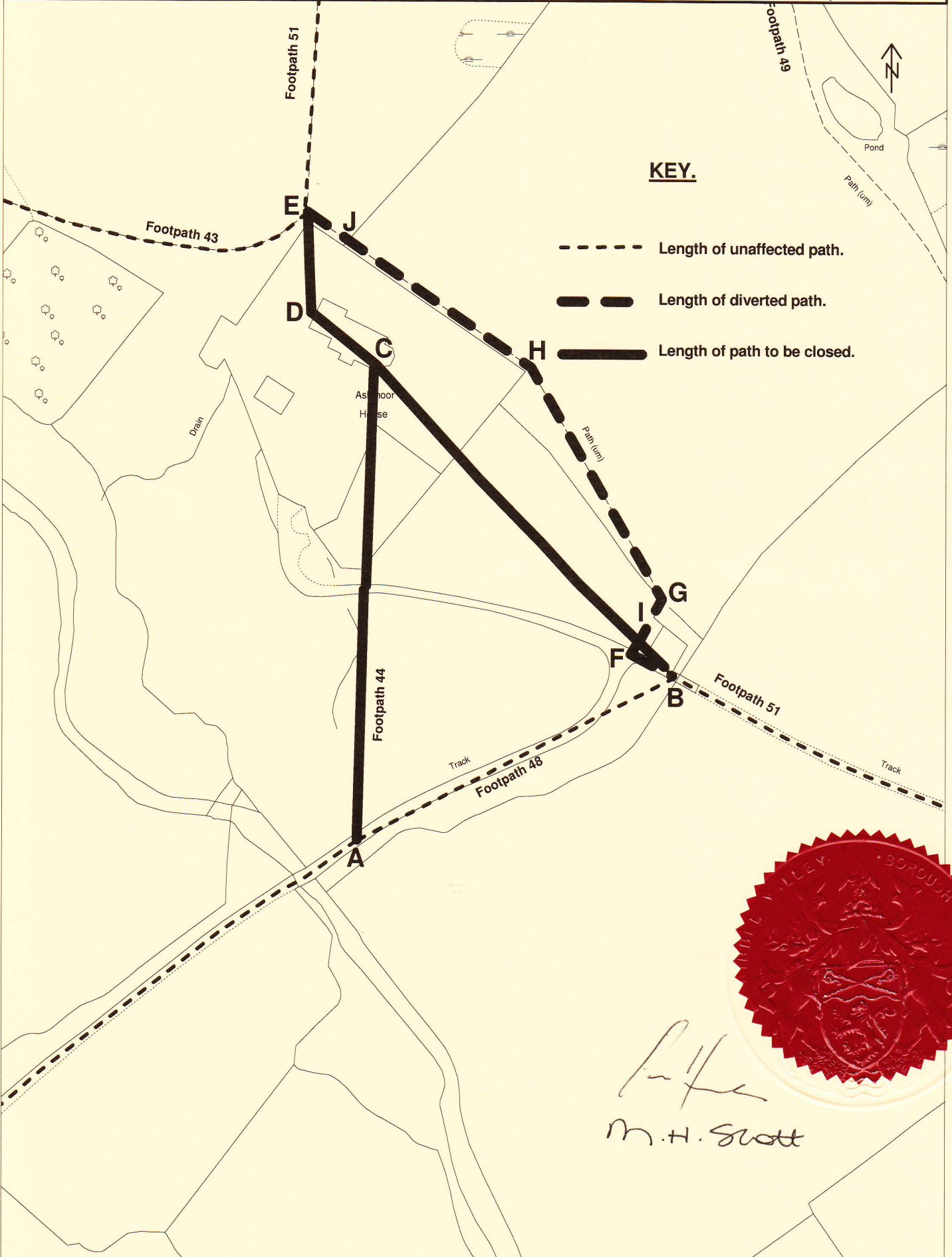
