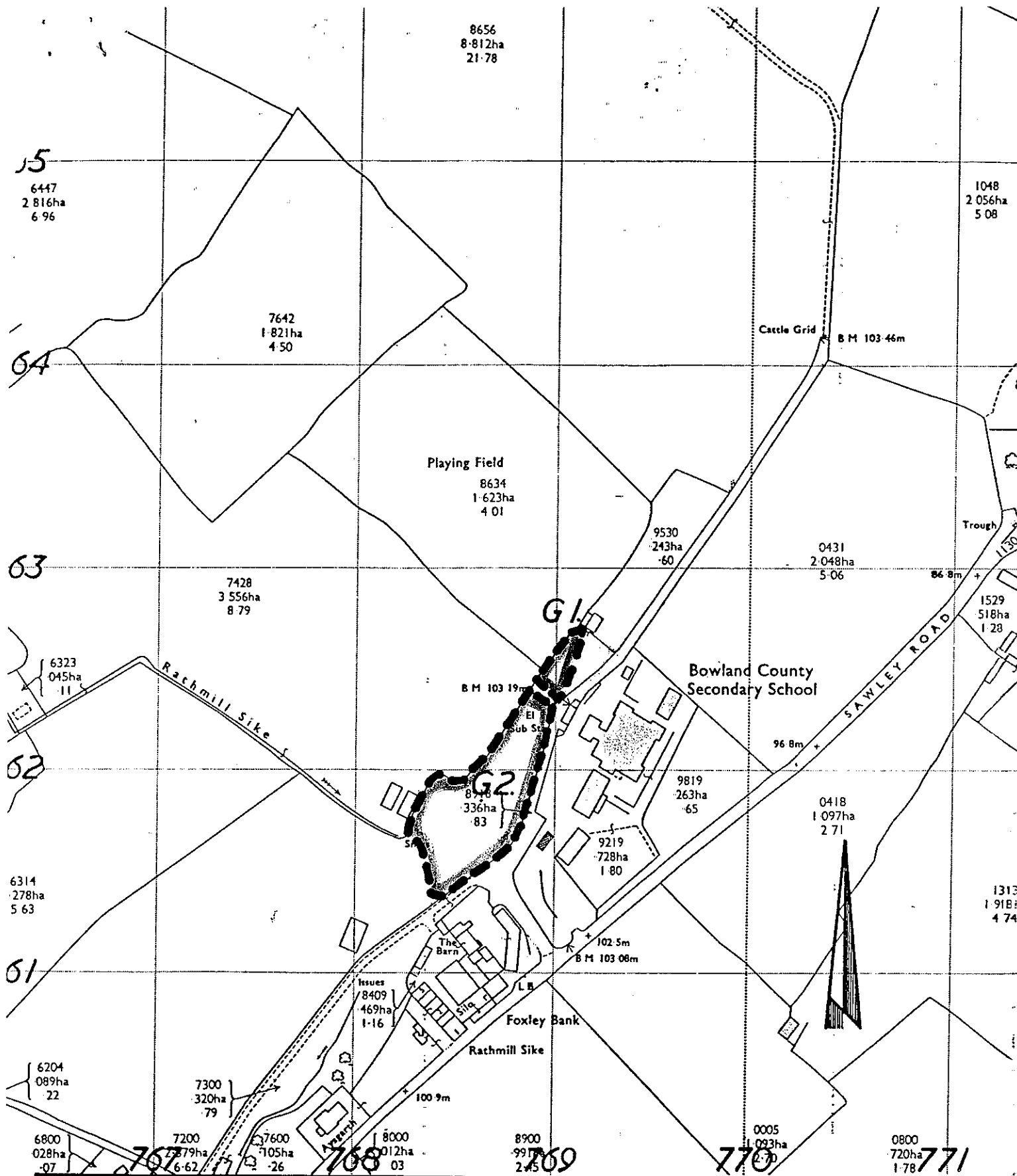
TREE PRESERVATION ORDER NO. 2 1984 RATHMILL SIKE, GRINDLETON

REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The site in question has been in the ownership of Lancashire County Council, but is now up for sale, and likely to be sold to a local farmer.

The trees, being mixed and largely mature, form an impressive and attractive feature, important in the area for the occupants of the surrounding residential properties.

It is considered necessary to protect the trees on the site with a Tree Preservation Order to ensure their continued contribution to the amenity of the area.
