The Sub-Committee met to determine the application by the Derby Arms, Chipping Lane, Longridge, Preston PR3 2NB pursuant to Section 35 of the Licensing Act 2003 to vary the premises licence.

The purpose of the application was to extend the opening hours, times for the sale of alcohol and provision of regulated entertainment. To permit performances of dance the supply of late night refreshments.

In addition, the application sought approval for a change to the internal layout of the premises, removal of two of the conditions in Annex 2 and the inclusion of additional conditions to promote the four licensing objectives.

The Licensing Sub-Committee gave careful consideration to the report of the Chief Executive and to representations both written and verbal. The Sub-Committee also had regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the relevant regulations made under the Act, the licensing objectives and the Council's licensing policy and determined the application be granted and the premises licence be varied as applied for.
