I write to formally object to the above development

My objections are for the following reasons:

- The site is too close to residential areas
- The road is not suitable for the increase in HGV's and other goods vehicles that the site will bring. The local roads, Dilworth Lane, Stonebridge roundabout, Ribchester and Grimsargh bridge are ill equipped to cope with the current weight of traffic, and are certainly not equipped for any more.
