I write to ask you to exclude Chatsburn from your considerations for housing. Our village has had a great deal of housing built over the last few years, a survey was undertaken by the Parish Council trying to identify what was required in the way of housing stock, the response was poor and only a few people said there was a shortage of affordable. We now have that addressed with houses built off Ribbles Lane on an old mill site. We have awful problems of car parking, which is having "knock on" effects on our shops and the schools.

Most developers wish to build four or five bed houses priced at £600 to £800+ which certainly was not identified as required.

I wish to promote "High Moor" at the top of Pendle Road; now with a new roundabout ease of access to the A59 is a plus, being on the edge of the town with good bus service, within walking distance of junior school and senior school, will take traffic off the roads, all the facilities of the town within easy reach, it has a lot going for it as a expansion to the town.
