Subject: Objection to the settlement boundaries for Highmoor Farm

To whom it may concern

I am writing to express my objection to the proposed settlement boundary changes for Highmoor Farm which will potentially lead to applications for further housing developments to be submitted.

If further housing developments occur on this area of land it is going to place and even larger strain on the already busy Pendle Road. It is becoming more and more unsafe to drive and walk along Pendle Road, in both directions. This is due to the increased volume of traffic and increased number of parked cars on the road side, this is particularly so when there are football matches on at Clitheroe Football Club. This parking has also included coaches, which have parked partially on the pavement all of which is causing restricted views for both drivers and pedestrians. This problem will only increase as the residents move into the houses already being built on Pendle Road. As the number of cars continues to increase the levels of poor air quality in the area will also continue to rise, will become most apparent when the queues of traffic waiting to access the A59 become even longer.
