With reference to my letter of 15<sup>th</sup> August 18 we have now had access to your submitted (Reg 22) HED DPD draft.

As we had not seen this document we were unable to send in our objections at the time so we would like to take this opportunity to put them forward now.

- (i) This land is better kept rural in all the residents opinion
- (ii) We don't feel that the houses are required on Haugh Head as the estate adjacent (50 yards away) is still not complete and numerous houses still not sold after a considerable number of years
- (iii) This is a very busy road with no speed limit, numerous corners, no lighting and very importantly no footpaths either side.
- (iv) There is no public transport for children, families or the elderly. If we can refer to the village of Saldon a number of families had to leave the area due to the ending of the bus service although it was reinstated to a certain degree it is rather too late for them

(v) There is a lack of all amenities for more dwellings.
