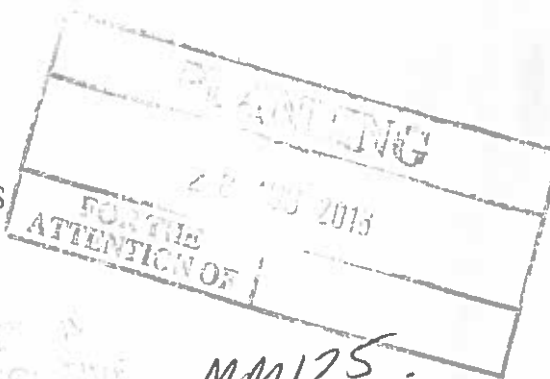

Dear John

I am writing to you in response to the new Additional Housing Allocations published as part of the local plan.

I do not support these new Housing Allocations in any way. I think that they would be hugely detrimental to Clitheroe and the local area. Not to mention the fact that it will do damage to the environment.

I think that Clitheroe has, quite frankly, had more than its fair share of housing developments and the infrastructure is already suffering under the weight of the current developments. Further housing will simply crush the town. I do not see that these sites are appropriate, being either on green field sites, or adjacent to other new developments. The local roads simply will not be able to support the traffic and local schools and health centres will not be able to cope.

The demand for housing is elsewhere and so it is entirely inappropriate to consider building further housing in Clitheroe. For this reason I would like my objections to the new housing allocations to be registered.
