Objection to Proposed Planning Re Site 24.

We are writing to you with our reasons for objecting to the above,

1. Traffic. The proposed site is situated on a narrow country Lane where there is NO speed restriction with 2 seriously dangerous bends (100 yards of each other); No Pavements and No street lights; the access to the site would appear to be adjacent to the existing farm drive and the public right of way across the field leading towards the tennis courts. also there is the only road entrance into the Meadow View

development on this bend.

2. No Medical services within Read and Simonstone

3. No Bus Service; No shops within a mile from the site

4. The site is within a Green Belt area which is always in use for sheep and cattle.

5. Meadow View Site commenced 4 years ago; properties still unsold; this shows that the demand is not there. Still room for more properties to be built on this site.
