Please note my comments below in respect of the above, as they relate to MM2-SITE Devpr3-Land off Hawthorne

This isn't the first time this road has to subject to the disruption of a housing developed which has eroded the ground affected the residents

There is a range of wildlife living on this site and this has been their established habit for probably centuries. This butterflies etc. This will be lost for ever and many of the species are already under threat.
