

REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

In accordance with Section 18C (1) of the Representation of the People Act 1983, Ribble Valley Borough Council gives notice that it is conducting a review of all polling districts and polling places for parliamentary elections.

Any elector from within the local authority area of Ribble Valley, or from within any parliamentary constituency which has any part in that area, may make a representation.
