

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION for the RIBBLE VALLEY CONSTITUENCY

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for Ribble Valley.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the (Acting) Returning Officer, Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA during normal working hours.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at the Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than **4 pm on Friday, 7 June 2024**.
4. The required £500 deposit may be paid either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the (Acting) Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including by debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds).
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 4 July 2024**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 Midnight on **Tuesday, 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
7. New applications to vote by post and amendments or cancellations of existing postal vote or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA by 5 pm on **Wednesday, 19 June 2024**.

8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA, by **5 pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024**. Applications can be made online in certain circumstances:

9. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications can be made online:

10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe, Lancashire BB7 2RA, by **5 pm on Thursday, 4 July 2024**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024**.
