

RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL
SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (TCPA 1847)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (2024-11)

1. Ribble Valley Borough Council gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being

- The length of Church Brow from St Mary Magdalenes Church to the junction with Church Street _____
- The length of Church Street in the Town Centre of Clitheroe extending from Church Brow to its junction with Market Place/ Wellgate _____
- The length of Market Place in the Town Centre of Clitheroe extending from the junction with Church Street to its junction with Castle Street/ King Lane _____
- The length of Lowergate from the junction with Wellgate to the junction with King Lane _____
- The length of Wellgate from the junction with Market Place to the junction with Lowergate _____
- The length of King Lane from the junction with Lowergate to the junction with Market Place/ Castle Street _____
- The length of Castle Street from its junction with King Lane/ Market Place to its junction with Castlegate _____

2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highway specified in paragraph 1 during the following event, the Remembrance Sunday procession.

3. The Order shall come into operation at 08.00am on Sunday 10 November 2024 and will remain in force until 12.30pm on Sunday 10 November 2024.

4. While the Order is in operation, traffic including bicycle and pedestrian movement along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) between 08.00am and 12.30pm

5. All restrictions will be signed (and staffed) and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer.

•Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which the Order applies.

7.Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order.

8.All constables are directed to enforce the provision of this Order.


9.The promoter of the event is Clitheroe Town Council.
