SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (TCPA 1847)

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (2025-3)

1. Ribble Valley Borough Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highways being –

- The length of Berry Lane in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from the junction with Derby Road to its junction with Market Place _____
- The length of Market Place in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from the junction with Berry Lane to its junction with Kestor Lane _____
- The length of Kestor Lane in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from its junction with Market Place to its junction with Derby Road _____
- The length of Derby Road in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from its junction with Kestor Lane to its junction with Berry Lane _____
- The length of Calder Avenue in the Town Centre of Longridge extending from its junction with Berry Lane to the Civic Hall _____

And shown coloured red on the plan attached to this Order.

2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highways specified in paragraph 1 during the following event, Longridge Field Day.

3. The Order shall come into operation at 10.30am on Saturday, 14 June 2025 and will remain in force until 03.00pm on Saturday, 14 June 2025.

4. While the Order is in operation all traffic including bicycles and pedestrian movement along the road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) between 10.30am and 03.00pm

5. There will be no alternative route available for the duration of the Order.

6. All restrictions will be signed (and staffed) and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

7. Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer.
- Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which the Order applies.

8. Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order.

9. All constables are hereby directed to enforce the provision of this Order.

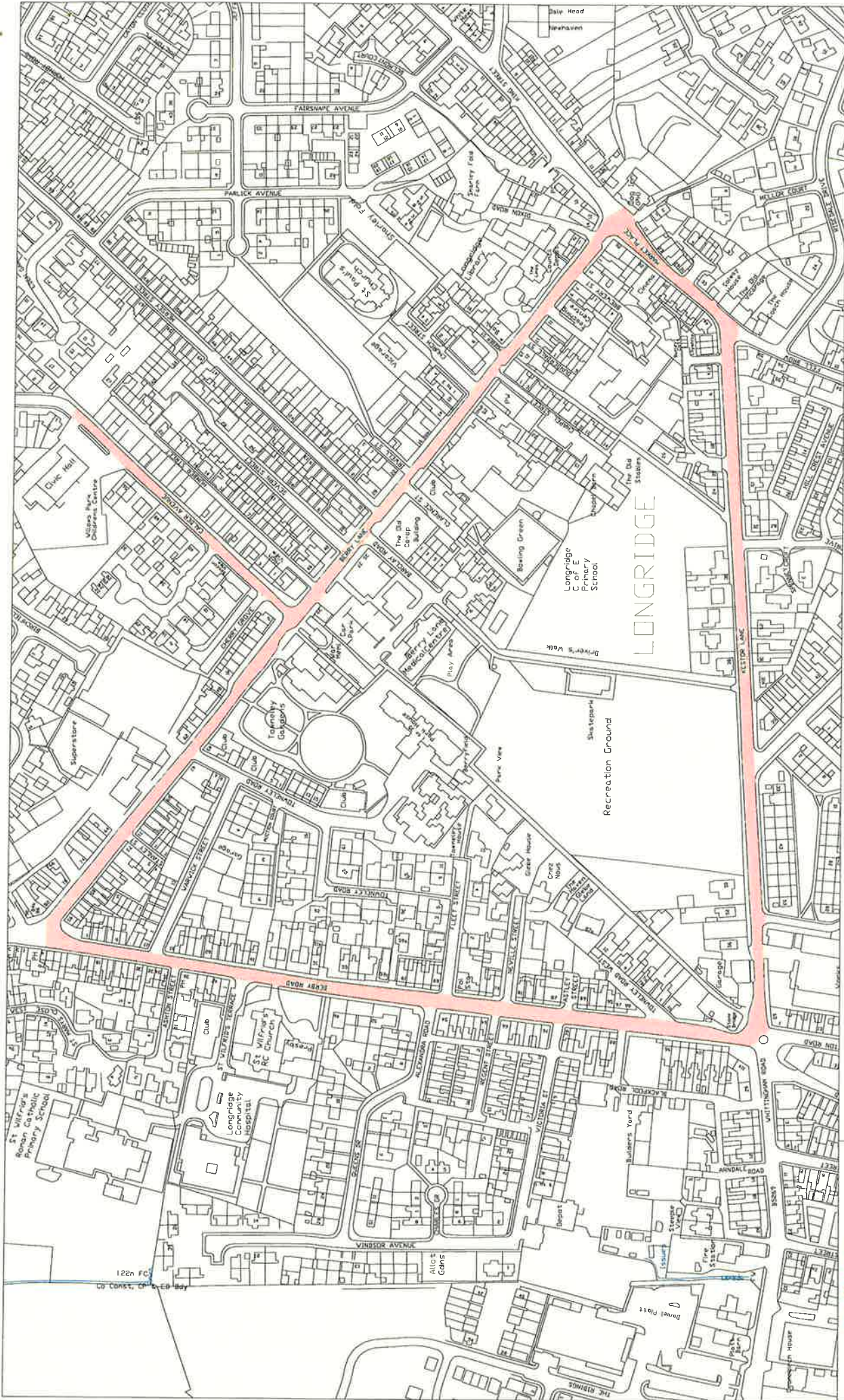
